Teaching Assistant Program

Purpose

Oregon School of Massage offers TA positions to help instructors provide an excellent educational experience for all students. Assistants benefit through a deeper learning of the material and through getting to know the community.

To Become a TA

To qualify for a TA position, students need to have completed two quarters at OSM (at least two classes and six months at OSM). To apply to become a TA, students must fill out an application, have the instructor sign it, and submit it to Lisa Barck Garofalo. Lisa will contact you about assignments before the term begins.

Compensation

This is a volunteer program. There is no monetary compensation. The Massage Fundamentals TA may be asked to attend Breitenbush if space permits. If they do, their room and board is given as compensation. TAs are expected to attend every class. LMTs who TA a class may receive continuing education hours, please see Lisa for a letter documenting your TA hours.

Possible TA responsibilities:

- 1) Record grades and attendance.
- 2) Make copies and overheads, set-up and run overhead and slide projectors.
- 3) Arrive early to set-up supplies, stay to put them away, open and close building.
- 4) Write on the board, erase the board, and straighten after class.
- 5) Proof tests, master notes, study questions.
- 6) Track what is covered in a day's lesson (write down).
- 7) Work with small groups.
- 8) Be a demonstration model.
- 9) Communicate with the office staff about make-up exams etc.
- 10) Serve as a liaison between students and teacher.
- 11) Assist the instructor by teaching some segments of the course.

OSM offers a free TA training program on a bi-annual basis. While not required, attendance is highly encouraged. LMTs who attend these trainings receive continuing education hours.
